# MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD ON APRIL 26, 2005

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Loren Bouma, Vernon Beernink, Mark Sybesma, John Degen and Stanley L. De Haan.

Minutes of Tuesday, April 19, 2005 were on motion and vote stand approved as distributed.

Melissa O'Rourke, County Attorney, reported that papers concerning Condemnation proceedings have been filed with Judge Walsh.

Shane Walter, County Community Services Director, met with the Board to request a signature on the Renewal of Decat Service Coordination Contract #DCAT04-014 in the amount of \$21,000. Decat is a process whereby a cluster of counties can roll unspent dollars to the next fiscal year. Those monies are then decatagorized so they can be spent in other areas.

Motion by Degen and supported by Beernink to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the aforementioned agreement. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

Mr. Walter also recommended that the Board sign an agreement with Cost Advisory Services, Inc. to recover eligible indirect costs from the Iowa Department of Human Services.

Robert Hagey, County Treasurer, met with the Board to report on a tax sale matter in Rock Township. Mr. Hagey informed the Board that a parcel of abandoned railroad right-of-way in Rock Township could be put back on the tax roles by serving a Notice of Expiration to all parties that have an interest in this parcel. Motion by Bouma,

supported by De Haan, to authorize the County Treasurer, to serve a 90 Day Notice of Expiration of Right to Redemption to all parties that have an interest in this parcel.

Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

After lengthy discussion on the cost and extent of remodeling the First Federal Building the matter was deferred to the Building Committee.

Motion by Beernink and supported by Bouma to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign an Agreement to Provide Professional Consulting Services with Cost Advisory Services, Inc. of Waukee to recover eligible indirect costs from the Iowa Department of Human Services. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

Motion by Degen and supported by De Haan to accept the following County Officer's quarterly report showing fees for the period ending March 31, 2005:

\$49,353.38. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

Motion by Bouma and supported by Beernink to approve the following Department Resolution:

## Resolution 2005-13

WHEREAS, it is unlawful for a department head to authorize the expenditure of a sum for a Department larger than the amount which has been appropriated for that department by the Board; and

WHEREAS, proposed expenditures for the General Services Department will increase in order to accommodate expenditures for the purchase of a new building, causing this department to exceed the amount budgeted for the fiscal year 2004-2005; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to increase the appropriations for the General Services Department to not be in violation of section 331.437, Iowa Code; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors that the appropriation for the General Services Department be increased from \$460,193 to \$510,193, and the appropriation for the Auditor's Department be decreased from \$726,376 to \$676,376.

The above and foregoing resolution was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, on April 26, 2005.
