

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MEETING HELD ON OCTOBER 12, 2010

10-10-12 1 The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Al Bloemendaal, John Degen, Arlyn Kleinwolterink, Mark Sybesma and Dennis Wright.

10-10-12 2 Minutes of the meeting held on September 28, 2010, were submitted and the Chairman declared them approved.

10-10-12 3 As this was the date and 9:30 the time set for a public hearing regarding the application by HPD Pork to construct two swine confinement barns with manure storage pit in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 in Section 21 of Center Township, the Chairman opened the public hearing. The application has a Master Matrix score of 440. Suzanne Haverdink, Zoning Assistant reported that the owner, Harry Dekkers has obtained signatures from all the landowners within a mile radius. No public comment was forthcoming. The Chairman closed the public hearing. The owners of HPD Pork, Harry and Pam Dekkers were present for this discussion. A letter recommending approval of this application will be forwarded to the DNR.

10-10-12 4 Joyce Vermeer, Northwest Early Childhood Iowa (NECI) Director met with the Board to tell them about the NECI program. Northwest Early Childhood Iowa serves children ages 0-5 in a four county area which includes Lyon, Sioux, Plymouth and Cherokee Counties. Priorities are: 1) Improving parenting skills in families with young children and 2) Enhancing childcare and preschool quality and availability. The Chairman thanked Vermeer for the work that NECI does on behalf of young children and their families in the area and especially in Sioux County.

10-10-12 5 Coleman McAllister, Sioux County Attorney brought one issue to the attention of the Board of Supervisors. He requested approval from the Board to retain the Heidman Law Firm to represent the County in an appeal by Sioux Pharm of the county infractions penalties imposed by the Court. Motion by Kleinwolterink and supported by Degen to approve the appointment and retention of the Heidman Law Firm to represent Sioux County in the county infraction appeal, with one member (Wright) abstaining from the vote.

10-10-12 6 Documents were submitted by Sioux County Engineer that needed Board approval and the Chairman's signature:

- Certificate of Completion and Final Acceptance of work for PCC overlay for Cedar Valley Corp.
- Progress voucher for final payment to contractor.
- Certificate of Completion and Final Acceptance of work for MLS of Granville for seeding of shoulders.

Motion by Wright and supported by Bloemendaal to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the aforementioned documents. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

- A permit agreement was submitted for approval – Southern Sioux Rural Water – to place a waterline within Sioux County ROW beneath Cherry Avenue between Section 7 of Eagle Township and Section 12 of Buncombe Township at 4083 Cherry Avenue.

Motion by Degen and supported by Kleinwolterink to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the permit agreement for Southern Sioux Rural Water. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

10-10-12 7 COMMITTEE REPORTS

- **Bloemendaal** – is the National Guard representative for Sioux County in the event of a disaster. He attended a disaster training meeting in Orange City. Training involved responding to an ice storm scenario. EOCs (Emergency Operations Centers) from three other counties - Osceola, Cherokee and Lyon were functioning as an EOC, from the Sioux County's EOC location. Emergency Management persons from each respective county were present to gain the most benefit from the exercise.
- **Kleinwolterink** – reported that a portion of this year's grain crop was sold last week.

10-10-12 8 Claims as submitted by the Sioux County Auditor were approved.

10-10-12 9 The Chairman left the meeting at 10:05.

10-10-12 10 The Vice-Chairman adjourned the meeting at 10:10 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, October 26, 2010.
