- **08-11-25 1** The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Dennis Wright, Vernon Beernink, Mark Sybesma, Arlyn Kleinwolterink and John Degen.

08-11-25 3 Coleman McAllister, County Attorney:

- Presented an update on statistics for case law.
- Reported that thirty-six prisoners are currently imprisoned at the Sioux County Public Safety Center.
- Expressed concern about the increase of at risk children in the County.

08-11-25 4 Open bids for Elevator Contract (Courthouse/DHS Buildings)

- Elevator Service and Repair \$265.00 per month
- Schumacher Elevator \$255.00 per month

Motion by Beernink and supported by Wright to continue to use the services of Elevator Service and Repair for one year pending review of the contract by the County Attorney. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

08-11-25 5 Shane Walter, Community Services Director:

- Presented a zoning matter to the Board. Concerns stemmed from a hog confinement at which damage was done to a county road because of the lack of a turnaround area for trucks. Walter proposed that an amendment be made to the Zoning Ordinance that requires a turnaround for all confinements in the County. The turnaround area must be prepared prior to beginning construction.
- Reported that wind generator companies have begun showing an interest in placing generators in the County. The current Zoning Ordinance does not address this issue. Walter will work with the Zoning Commission to revise the ordinance to set guidelines for the construction of wind generators.
