

**MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**MEETING HELD ON JANUARY 16, 2018**

- 1) The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Sybesma presiding. Members present were John Degen, Mark Sybesma, Dennis Wright, Arlyn Kleinwolterink, and Al Bloemendaal.
- 2) Minutes of the meeting held on January 9, 2018, were submitted, and the Chairman declared them approved.
- 3) Tom Kunstle, Sioux County Attorney, updated the Board on the Kami Schiebout case.
- 4) Cheryl Bunstma, Prevention Specialist, Compass Pointe, distributed information to the Board in regards to adult education on substance abuse being provided by the agency. The funding request totals \$1.00 per capita or \$34,898 for FY2019. The Board took no action on this request at this time.
- 5) Karen Schuiteman, Treasurer, Sioux County Youth Fair, presented the October 2016 through September 2017 profit and loss statement from the Youth Fair. Reported that the City of Sioux Center gave notice to the Fair Board to relocate the Fair Grounds in the next 5 years. Schuiteman requested a contribution in the amount of \$25,000 for FY2019. The Board took no action on the funding request at this time.
- 6) Dan Altena, Sioux County Sheriff, reviewed his FY2019 Sheriff budget as well as the Ambulance budget with the Board.
- 7) Rob Klocke, Sioux County Conservation Director,
  - Reviewed the FY2019 Conservation budget with the Board
  - Distributed the Conservation 5 year plan for upcoming projects
  - Reported that Conservation is looking to acquire the old school house in Buncombe Township and relocate it to Oak Grove
  - Reported that a new Conservation Board member is needed due to Brian Oordt moving out of the area.
- 8) Marty Guthmiller, CEO, Orange City Area Health System, reviewed the Public Health (Nurse) budget with the Board. Present for the discussion were Jackie Covey and Deb Vander Plaas. Public Health is requesting \$9.52 per capita or \$332,314 in funding. The current year rate is \$8.52 per capita or \$297,314 in funding. The Board received the budget for information at this time.
- 9) Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer
  - Presented a contract modification document for Board approval on project BROS CO84(155)—5F-84 on K24. The refund will be approximately \$1,625. Motion by Wright and supported by Degen to approve the contract modification for the said project. Motion carried unanimously.
  - Reported on secondary road activities.
  - Informed the Board that the County now owns propane tanks in Hawarden and Ireton locations and no longer rent tanks for those areas.

**10) Committee Reports:**

- **Kleinwolverink** – Attended a Landfill meeting.
- **Wright** – Attended an advisory meeting on January 10 for the Sioux Rivers Mental Health Region. The status of the Region was discussed.
- **Wright & Sybesma** – Reported on the Sioux Rivers Mental Health Region meeting from January 11. An attorney representing Siouxland Mental Health was present for this meeting. A vote was taken which made Sioux County the fiscal agent for the Region beginning July 1, 2018 for fiscal year 2019.
- **Bloemendaal & Sybesma** – Reported on the Airport Board meeting from January 15. Hangars were the main topic at this meeting. The FAA requires a payment of approximately \$19,000 to do the checks and fly-overs prior to the airport opening. The airport will be open beginning in November of 2018. The Airport Board approved expense to place tile for two adjacent landowners to help mitigate land erosion in those fields.
