- 3) Tom Kunstle, Sioux County Attorney, discussed the process by which the vacancy of County Treasurer can be filled. The first option is if the Board chooses to appoint a replacement this must be done within 40 days of the vacancy, and under this provision, notice of the intention to appoint shall be published no less than 4 days and no more than 20 days of the date of appointment. Unless there is a county-wide special election called, this vacancy will be filled on the November 3, 2020 General Election ballot. Candidates for this vacancy will use the

political party convention certificate process to be placed on the November 3, 2020 General Election ballot. The convention certificate is to be filed with the County Auditor by 5:00 PM, Wednesday, August 26, 2020.

The second option is to call for a county-wide special election and the first date this could occur is Tuesday, July 7, 2020.

Motion by Bloemendaal and supported by Vande Weerd to proceed with the first option to appoint a replacement for the vacant County Treasurer position. Voice vote: Vande Weerd, Yes, Bloemendaal, Yes, Degen, Yes, Sybesma, Abstained, Muilenburg, Yes. Motion carried.

The County Auditor will form an advertisement for the position and will advertise as soon as possible. The County Auditor will accept the applications for the position.

- 4) Chairman Muilenburg requested that discussion of the filling the County Treasurer position and a review of the County building closures to the public due to COVID-19, be placed on the May 12, 2020, Board agenda.
- 5) Motion by Vande Weerd and supported by Bloemendaal to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 9:20 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, May 12, 2020.
