

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

MEETING HELD ON OCTOBER 27, 1998

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock A.M. with Chairman Loren Bouma presiding. Members present were William Vander Maten, Vernon Beernink, Loren Bouma, Bernard L. Smith and Hubert Schuller.

The minutes of October 20, 1998, were read and on motion and vote stand approved as read.

Committee reports were given this date.

Terry Glade, architect for Ruble, Mamura, Moss, Brygger Architects, met with the Board this date to update them on the County Attorney Remodel Project and recommended that a date and time be set for a hearing and letting on the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated cost of the improvement.

Dennis Sassman, County Community Services Director, met with the Board this date to report on total expenditures for child welfare services for fiscal year 1998.

Motion by Beernink and supported by Smith to set November 24, 1998, at 10:00 o'clock A.M. as the date and time for a hearing and letting on the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated cost of the improvement for the County Attorney Remodel Project on the third floor of the Court House. Carried, unanimous in favor.

Mark Schouten, County Attorney, met with the Board this date to review carpet selections made by the interior decorator for Ruble, Mamura, Moss, Brygger Architects for the County Attorney Remodel Project on the third floor of the Court House. He stated that he would also consult with Sharon Vande Steeg, interior decorator for Kraai Furniture, about recommended carpet selections for the County Attorney Remodel Project.

Doug Julius, County Engineer, met with the Board this date to discuss a possible purchase of additional real estate located south of the City of Chatsworth for gravel purposes.

The consensus of the Board was to instruct Doug Julius, County Engineer, to also

investigate the possibility of purchasing a smaller tract from a property owner adjacent to the current gravel source near the City of Chatsworth.

Motion by Vander Maten and supported by Smith to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the following documents:

Permit Agreement with Poppema-Sikma Construction, Sheldon, for a road right-of-way crossing located directly west of Lot 12 in the Hull Industrial Subdivision in the Incorporated City of Hull.

Permit Agreement with Frontier Communications of Iowa, Fort Dodge, for road right-of-way crossings in Sections 17 and 20 of Nassau Township.

Permit Agreement with Hospers Telephone Company, Hospers, for a road right-of-way crossing in Section 1 of Floyd Township.

Permit Agreement with U.S. Communications, Inc., Denver, Colorado, for a road right-of-way crossing in Section 4 of Settlers Township.

Weed Commissioner's Report for calendar year 1998.

Carried, unanimous in favor.

Motion by Beernink and supported by Smith to approve and authorize the County Engineer to purchase a third pup gravel trailer from Drake Equipment Company, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, in an amount of \$23,365.52. Carried, unanimous in favor.

The Board approved payment of claims as presented by the County Auditor from all Departments this date.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting until November 10, 1998.
