

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ORANGE CITY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the city of Orange City, in the County of Sioux, State of Iowa, that the Special Election of said City will be held on Tuesday, September 10, 2019, at the following precincts and polling places:

<u>PRECINCT</u>	<u>POLLING PLACE</u>
1. Orange City #1 Precinct	Living Water Community Church, Orange City
2. Orange City #2 Precinct	Living Water Community Church, Orange City

Polls will be open from 7:00a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Absentee ballots will be available as of Monday, August 12, 2019, for those voters who plan to be absent for the upcoming Special Orange City Election to be held on September 10, 2019. A qualified voter may come to the Auditor's Office in Orange City to personally cast his or her vote. This may be done up through 4:30 p.m. on Monday, September 9, 2019. For absentee voting purposes, the Auditor's Office will be open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

A qualified voter may also request an absentee ballot in writing but it must be on an Iowa Official Absentee request form.

The deadline to request a ballot to be mailed is 5:00 p.m., Friday, August 30, 2019.

All ballots returned through the mail must be postmarked before Election Day. For more information concerning absentee voting, the Sioux County Auditor's Office at (712)-737-2216.

Absentee and special voter ballots will be counted at: Sioux County Courthouse.

All voters are advised as to the requirements of voter registration in order to be eligible to vote at said election.

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle.
