- 1) The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were John Degen, Carl Vande Weerd, Al Bloemendaal, Jerry Muilenburg, and Mark Sybesma.

- 4) Ryan Dokter, Sioux County Auditor, presented the results for the 2019 City/School Election held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 for the 2nd-tier canvass. 5) Shane Walter, CEO Sioux Rivers Mental Health Region

- Reported that O'Brien County was formally approved into the Region by Lyon, Plymouth, and Sioux County and will officially join July 1, 2020. The Region Board will approve the 28E agreement on November 26, 2019.
- A request to join the Sioux Rivers Region was received from Dickinson County. The process to accept them into the Region will begin at the November 26, 2019 meeting.

6) Shane Walter, Sioux County Zoning Director, reported that a Planning and Zoning meeting will take place at 7:00 PM on November 21. The P & Z Board will consider an application to construct a truck wash near Hospers.

7) Micah Van Maanen, Sioux County IT Director, requested Board approval to purchase a .gov domain name for Sioux County. There is a push from the Federal government for government entities to secure .gov domains for security purposes. Only government entities can purchase .gov domains. Motion by Degen and supported by Muilenburg to approve the purchase of the .gov domain name for Sioux County. Motion carried unanimously.

8) Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer,

- Updated the Board on secondary road activities.
- December 3 is the date the auction closes for selling 3 trucks on Purple Wave. Road line maintenance painting continues as weather permits.

9) Committee Reports:

- **Sybesma, Vande Weerd, & Bloemendaal** – Attended the recent Sioux County Library Association meeting.
- **Vande Weerd** – Attended the recent Hull Chamber meeting.
- **Bloemendaal** – Attended the recent Sioux Center Chamber meeting.
- **Degen** – 1) Reported that the County will pursue a 3-year service contract with Trane for the courthouse systems. 2) Attended the Premier Communication event at Van Driesen Farms. 3) Reported on a meeting he had with the Fire Chief of Maurice in regards to the County or Airport Board contributing some funding for the Fire Department’s new first response truck. This truck would be first to the scene if a fire happened at the airport.
- **Muilenburg** – Reported on the Landfill meeting. The agency is switching to an HSA health insurance plan.
- **Sybesma** – Reported on the Airport Board meeting. Drainage issues continue to be addressed. Work is being done on the 5-year plan, which includes a cross runway for 2025. People are being placed on a list to get into hangars. A \$150,000 grant from the Federal government is received each year for equipment and the plan is to purchase a new loader for snow removal.
