Summary: To authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of Boyden effective January 1, 2022.

The use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax shall be changed in the City of Boyden effective January 1, 2022.

PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX:

If the change is approved, revenues from the local sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

0% for property tax relief.

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are:

100% for capital improvements or any other lawful purpose.
