Sioux County Auditor

Sioux County, Iowa, is currently taking applications for a full-time County Auditor to begin work no later than February 1, 2023. The office of Sioux County Auditor will be vacant as of December 24, 2022.

The Sioux County Board of Supervisors intends to fill the vacancy by appointment. The office of County Auditor is an elected office, and the successful candidate will fill the remainder of the unexpired term, through December 31, 2024, or until a special election if one is called, whichever occurs first.

The person appointed to the office of Sioux County Auditor is required to have resided in Sioux County for at least 60 days prior to appointment.

Duties Include:

- Performing and/or overseeing Sioux County financial functions (including payroll, accounts payable, audits, annual reporting, and fixed assets)
- Creating & overseeing the Sioux County budget
- Overseeing elections
- Serving as the Clerk for the Sioux County Board of Directors
- Certifying city, school district, township & miscellaneous budgets
- Supervising staff who work in the Auditor's Office

Salary: \$86,984 with generous medical and retirement benefits.
