

The Board of Supervisors (BOS) of Sioux County, IA, met at 9 AM with Chairman Jerry Muilenburg presiding. Members present were Muilenburg, John Degen, Craig Hoftzyer, Dan Altena & Carl Vande Weerd.

Agenda for the meeting of 12-19-23 submitted. Motion by Vande Weerd supported by Degen. Unanimous

Minutes of the meeting of 12-12-23 presented. Motion by Hoftzyer supported by Altena. Unanimous.

Dick Sievers, representing Mid Sioux Opportunity, introduces new Executive Director Cindy Harpenau. She will move to this position effective 1/1/24. Sievers reviews operations and the services Mid Sioux provides. Requests funding of \$19,000 for budget FY2025. FY2024 funding was \$7500.

Jesse Van Donge, representing the Sioux County Youth Fair, presents 2023 financial data and requests funding of \$25,000 for budget FY2025. FY2024 funding was \$25,000.

Kurt Franje, representing Habitat for Humanity, reviews operations and the mission of Habitat for Humanity. Requests funding of \$5000 for budget FY2025. FY2024 funding was \$2500.

Sioux County Attorney Thomas Kunstle presents 28E agreement and related Resolution 2023-42 establishing the Sioux County Agriculture and Exposition Center. Motion by Vande Weerd supported by Altena. Voice votes. Muilenburg (Yes), Hoftzyer (Yes), Degen (Yes), Altena (Yes) and Vande Weerd (Yes).

The Ordinance Adopting Code of Ordinances (recodification) per Iowa Code 331.302(10)(a) is presented for approval. Iowa Code requires recodification every 5 years. Motion by Vande Weerd supported by Degen. Unanimous.

Becky Erdman, representing the Genesis House, discusses operations and the services provided by the Genesis House and requests funding of \$5000 for budget FY2025. FY2024 funding was \$5000.

Janelle Volkers, representing Evensong Hospice, presents the plan for a non-profit private hospice home that is brand new and coming to Sioux County. Requests funding of \$20,000 or more for budget FY2025. FY2024 funding was \$0.

Funding requests of \$5,363.80 from Northwest Iowa Planning and Development Corporation (NWIPDC) and \$500 from Western Iowa Tourism received via mail are noted. FY2024 funding was \$5,363.80 and \$500 respectively.
