

- The Board of Supervisors (BOS) of Sioux County, IA, met at 9 AM with chairperson Jerry Muilenburg presiding. Members present were Muilenburg, John Degen, Craig Hoftzyer, Dan Altena & Carl Vande Weerd.
- Agenda for the meeting of 06/25/24 submitted. Motion to approve by Altena supported by Vande Weerd. Unanimous.
- Minutes of the 06/11/24 meeting presented. Motion to approve by Degen supported by Hoftzyer. Unanimous.
- Carl Vande Weerd, Supervisor, discusses HHS building roof replacement. Bid came in at just under \$50,000. Motion by Degen to approve using ARPA funds supported by Altena. Unanimous.
- Justin Jacobsma, Williams & Co. PC, presents the FY2023 finalized audit report. Motion to approve by Vande Weerd supported by Hoftzyer. Unanimous.
- Joe E Van Tol, Sioux County Auditor, updated the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) fund update for information.
- Shane Walter, Sioux County Planning & Zoning Administrator, presents Resolution 2024-28 Zoning Fee Resolution. Motion by Vande Weerd supported by Altena to approve with minor adjustments to the fee schedule verbiage. Voice votes. Vande Weerd (Yes), Altena (Yes), Hoftzyer (Yes), Degen (Yes), Muilenburg (Yes).
- Vande Weerd discusses lease agreement of fairgrounds old runway to Zomer Company Realty & Auction. Motion by Vande Weerd to continue the lease for 07/01/24 – 06/30/25 supported by Hoftzyer. Unanimous.
- Craig Hoftzyer reviews a contract with the fair board for use of the fairground’s property from 07/01/24 – 07/31/24. Motion by Hoftzyer supported by Altena to approve with a few dates adjusted in the contract supported by Altena. Unanimous.
- Thomas Kunstle, Sioux County Attorney, updates on status of new Iowa regarding possible deportation of illegal aliens detained in the state of Iowa. Law was to take effect 07/01/24 but law was challenged and an injunction is currently in place.
- Joel Sikkema, Sioux County Engineer, discusses impact of recent flooding on Sioux County roads. Answers questions about the effect of flooding on employees, possible funding for road damage repair due to the flooding, safety, and the damage to the Alton shop. Sioux County is BOS is very thankful for the dedication of Secondary Roads staff! Motion is made by Altena supported by Vande Weerd to give Sikkema interim authority to approve utility permits and get signatures from the BOS after approval just to keep things moving in Secondary Roads offices as the flooding has made them extremely busy. Updates on equipment purchases and discusses GPS software currently being considered by Secondary Roads department.
- Liquor License for La Corita Jalisco LLC presented. Motion by Degen to approve supported by Vande Weerd. Unanimous.
- Noted the first BOS meeting in November will be scheduled for Wednesday November 13 Versus the normal Tuesday schedule to allow for election canvassing finalization Tuesday November 12. Monday November 11 is Veterans Day with county offices being closed.
- Claims for 06/25/24 presented. Motion to approve by Altena supported by Hoftzyer. Unanimous.
- Committee Reports:
 - Hoftzyer – Board of Health (BOH) meeting – the contract with Sioux County for FY2025 service forthcoming very soon – Community Health Partners (CHP) is providing Bird Flu education with local dairies as possible
 - Degen – Conservation has postponed/cancelled indefinitely its 100-year celebration due to flooding
 - Altena – Noted some of his future committee meetings will be Zoom only due to road closings due to flooding
 - Vande Weerd – Remodel updates – thanked other BOS members for their cities and staffs with flood assistance throughout the county
 - Muilenburg – County Safety meeting, Landfill meeting – Landfill closure fund guarantee discussed
- Motion to adjourn by Vande Weerd supported by Hoftzyer. Unanimous. Adjourned at approximately 11:20 AM.
