



- The Board of Supervisors (BOS) of Sioux County, IA, met at 9:00 AM with chairperson Jerry Muilenburg presiding. Members present were Muilenburg, Craig Hoftzyer, John Degen & Carl Vande Weerd.
- Agenda for the 11/13/24 meeting submitted. Motion to approve by Vande Weerd supported by Degen. Unanimous.
- Minutes of the 10/29/24 meeting presented. Motion to approve by Hoftzyer supported by Degen. Unanimous.
- Ashley Riibe, Elections Administrator, presents canvassing for the November 5, 2024, general election. 19,079 total ballots were cast on or before election day in Sioux County which is an 80.23% turnout. Notes that overall, the election went well. Motion to approve results by Degen supported by Vande Weerd. Unanimous.
- Stephanie Henrich, representing the Centers Against Abuse and Sexual Assault (CAASA) presents a request for FY2026 funding from Sioux County in the amount of \$7000 and gives an overview of what CAASA does and gives some information on the past year for CAASA.
- Claims for 11/13/24 presented. Motion to approve by Hoftzyer supported by Vande Weerd. Unanimous.
- Committee Reports:
 - o Hoftzyer–attended Sioux County Ag Expo – they are considering constructing some of the small outbuildings in 2025 depending upon funding.
 - o Degen–attended Conservation-flood repairs continue-request for an ATV park in Sioux County received- Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is wanting to put an additional person in Sioux County to monitor rivers better-Sioux County would be responsible for a portion of the cost. Conservation Director to appear before the BOS in the future regarding this. Attended EMS where EMS Director Nate Huizenga noted he will be resigning as EMS Director effective 06/30/25-will remain as a deputy in the sheriff department. Currently 75% EMS/25% sheriff deputy.
 - o VandeWeerd–Information Technology (IT) staff to move to its newly remodeled space next week and Attorney staff to move to its newly remodeled space in December. Appraiser has been hired for FEMA and will be appraising the 6 homes not in any city limits in Sioux County considering a buyout.
 - o Muilenburg–no report
- Joel Sikkema, County Engineer, asks for approval for 2 utility agreements. A water line crossing for Southern Sioux Rural Water and a water main for the City of Sioux Center. Motion to approve by Vande Weerd supported by Degen. Unanimous. Notes upcoming De Raad gravel pit mining\crushing, reports on K18 shoulder widening and updates on B20 bridge near Northwest Iowa Community College (NCC) as a flood response item. Discusses new rail tanker to be used for temporary drainage and answers questions on other general secondary roads items.
- Compensation Board process is discussed and the meeting to come up with a recommended wage increase percentage to use for budgeting is set as part of the December 3, 2024, BOS meeting.
- Motion to adjourn by Vande Weerd supported by Degen. Unanimous. Adjourned at approximately 10:00 AM.
