

- The Board of Supervisors (BOS) of Sioux County, IA, met at 9:00 AM with chairperson Jerry Muilenburg presiding. The members present were Muilenburg, Craig Hoftzyer, John Degen, Dan Altena & Carl Vande Weerd.
- Agenda for the 04/08/25 meeting submitted. Motion to approve by Altena supported by Degen. Unanimous.
- Minutes for the 04/01/25 meeting presented. Motion to approve by Vande Weerd supported by Hoftzyer. Unanimous.
- Thomas Kunstle, County Attorney, discusses Resolution 2025-18 Disposal of approximately 28 acres of county owned property (part of old Sioux Center Airport property) from Sioux County to the Sioux County Ag Expo. Motion to approve by Vande Weerd supported by Hoftzyer. Voice votes. Vande Weerd (Yes), Altena (Yes), Muilenburg (Yes), Degen (Yes) and Hoftzyer (Yes). Notes discussions regarding a possible long-term lease of county owned property and gives information/advice on options on how to proceed while meeting Iowa law. Further discussions are still needed. Reviews an end of the workday disturbance on courthouse grounds where City of Orange City police were called and engaged a person who was loitering and possibly filming courthouse employees as they left work. A police report has been filed.
- Joel Sikkema, County Engineer, presents utility agreement with Northwest Iowa Power Company (NIPCO). Motion to approve by Hoftzyer supported by Altena. Unanimous. Notes Iowa legislative discussions on a potential levy for secondary roads. Mentions land Right of Way (ROW) purchase discussions with landowner on dirt road south of Rock Valley that is scheduled to be graded and graveled. General discussions on road washout near Hyman pit and on county road ditch cleanout rules are held. Motion by Hoftzyer supported by Degen to go into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5(1)(j).
- After exiting closed session Anita Nykamp is presented for approval as a new Holland Township Clerk to replace the retiring Clerk. Motion to approve by Altena supported by Degen. Unanimous.
- Abstract of Votes for previously approved Boyden Hull Community School District Physical Plant and Equipment Levy (PPEL) election signature request presented. A third copy is needed for the attorney firm that assisted the school with preparation of the PPEL documents.
- Claims are presented. General discussions on a few specific claims are held. Motion to approve by Altena supported by Degen. Unanimous.
